

Hana is an old dog which lives with the Yoshida family. She usually sits and doesn't move a lot. She sometimes walks to a window and sees outside. She is so old that she can't run around the house.

When she was two months old, she started to live with (\textcircled) a puppy family. A puppy family means a family doing a kind of volunteer work. It grows the dogs which will become service dogs in the future. Mr. and Mrs. Yoshida became Hana's puppy family. Hana had a good time with Mr. and Mrs. Yoshida and their daughter, Michiko and their son, Taiki. Michiko liked going for a walk with Hana very much. Every morning and evening, she took Hana to the beach near their house. Taiki wanted to go for a walk with his sister and Hana, but he was too young to go with them. When Michiko went to school, Taiki was happy because he could have enough time to play with Hana. While Hana was staying with them, she $(\lor)(live / learned / people / how to / with)$.

When Hana was one year old, she had to leave Mr. and Mrs. Yoshida's house and go to the training center for service dogs which help disabled people. Michiko and Taiki didn't want Hana to go, so they cried and cried. Hana was very sad, too.

Hana began training at the center. The people in the training center taught her many things needed to be a service dog. For example, when the person wanted her to bring the pen on a table, she had to go and bring it to him. When the person wanted to take off his shoes, she tried to help him. One of the things that she wasn't good at was opening and closing doors. It was very difficult for her to open and close a door with her feet and mouth. She practiced (5)<u>it</u> many times. When she was successful, the people in the center said to her, "Good, Hana! You're a very nice dog!" She was really glad to hear that, so she didn't give up her training. She stayed there for more than twelve months and finally she became a service dog.

The person she started to live with was a girl called Yumiko. Yumiko was twelve years old and wasn't able to use her leg because she had a car accident. After the accident, she didn't go out to see her friends because she didn't want her friends to see her wheelchair. Yumiko became very happy when she saw Hana for the first time. Yumiko wanted to keep a dog as a pet, but she knew that she couldn't take care of it. However, Hana could help her and also became her friend. They went to the park together, watched TV together and slept together. Living with Hana gave Yumiko the power to try new things. She started some sports (\grave{z}) such (_____) swimming and wheelchair tennis. While she was playing sports, she made new friends. One day, Yumiko's father said to Hana, "Thank you, Hana. Thank you very much. After the accident, Yumiko looked very sad, and stayed home all day. She only talked with us. But now, she looks very happy. You really helped her."

When Hana became ten years old, she left Yumiko's house. She was too old to take care of Yumiko. Hana started to live with the Yoshida family again. When she arrived, Michiko and Taiki said to her, "Welcome back, Hana! We are really (3) again." They are really enjoying living with Hana. However, Hana can't run around their house and she doesn't want to go for a walk with Michiko very much. She sleeps all day and only moves her tail. Michiko and Taiki think it is OK. "She has done a great job. She doesn't have to work for other people anymore." Every day, Hana is sitting beside the window. Michiko thinks Hana is remembering her life.
